



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

On scientific and educational cooperation
between
Warsaw University of Life Sciences – SGGW
and
Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University

With the objective of promoting academic exchange and cooperation between the two institutions, they hereby agree to the following:

- Based upon the principles of respecting other's independence and mutual benefit, the two institutions agree to explore the possibilities of:
 - research in the fields of mutual interest
 - improvement of academic staff's skills
 - exchange of academic staff and students
 - introducing new curricula
 - joint research projects
 - joint educational programs
 - exchange of publications and teaching materials
- In order to initiate any of the above mentioned activities, detailed working plans should be elaborated in the future that would result from mutual consultation and negotiations and would be signed by both institutions.
- 3. This Memorandum shall impose no financial obligations of either institution. It is understood that financial arrangements will be negotiated in each specific case and will depend of the availability of funds. Each party agrees to seek financial resources for above mentioned activities. It is also understood that the details of joint activities will be negotiated for each specific case.
- 4. The Memorandum is effective on the date of the signature hereto and will remain in effect for the initial period of 5 years. It can be extended for a period as mutually agreed by both parties. The Memorandum can be terminated by either institution by giving two months notice to the other party.



Guj girl in Poland to study vultures' eco impact

Palanpur: An MSc final year student of Life Sciences in Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University has gone to Poland to further her studies on disappearing vultures and the dis-balance this has created in the socio-ecological sphere.

Jill Patel has left for Poland on Friday as part of student exchange programme after a MoU was signed with Polish Academy of Sciences. Her doctoral thesis on 'Ecological Service Provided by Vulture', based on particularly the funeral customs of the Parsi community,

who dispose of their dead at the "Tower of Silence" for vultures to feed.

Jill is studying on how the community is being inconvenienced after the bird species started to dwindle in numbers rapidly.

Her guide Nishith Dharaiya, assistant professor of life sciences at the university had trained her for three months, while in Poland Jill will be guided in her research work by professor from the Polish Academy of Science, Nuria Selva, for another three months until March end.

The researcher will be given free accommodation and other facilities like institute fee, lab fee by the Polish government for her research work.

Dhariya, who had done research on sloth bears in North Gujarat, told TOI: "Jill was selected for the thesis on merit basis both by the local guide as well as the Polish guide, Selva. The aim of her study is to rethink on an alternative to the age-old Parsi ritual in view of declining population of vultures. We have also contacted around 80 people including priests in south Gujarat where the community thrives in large numbers for their perspectives in our study."




