Policy for Selection of Gender Champions 2.0

Every year one male & one Female candidate will be selected as Gender Champion.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1. Gender Champions can be any student above 17 years of age
- 2. Should be enrolled and regularly attending in any University campus Department.
- 3. She/He must have secured minimum of 60% marks or equivalent grade in last/ Previous Semester Examination of UG/PG.
- 4. Excellent oral, written and presentation skills
- 5. Excellent understanding of the socio-cultural issues and prevailing gender norms and practices
- 6. Students' enrollment for this championship must be through the proper channel.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1. The students who want to participate in gender champion competition has to apply through proper channel in prescribed application form. The application form should be dually signed and filled.
- 2. Interested students has to attend a workshop/seminar arranged by university and will be award about socio-cultural issues and prevailing gender norms and practices.
- 3. All Students shall have to participate compulsory in workshop/ seminar as decided by organizers for being selected as gender champion. They have to appear in a written test and have to secure at least 40% marks. Students who have secured 40% marks shall be considered as qualify standard for second round ie Presentation round.
- 4. Those students who get 50% marks in presentation will be qualify for the final round i. e. Debate Round.
- In debate competition final winner will be selected as Gender Champions (one male and one female) of HNGU Campus

- 6. In selection of Gender champions, Decision of the selection Committee will be final.
- 7. If number of applications received for Gender champions is less than 15, then debate competition will only be the only final round to declare gender champion.

BENEFITS TO THE GENDER CHAMPIONS

- 1. She/He shall be felicitated by Honorable VC of HNG University.
- 2. She/He shall be given a certificate considering her/him as Gender Champion.
- 3. A Gender Champion Badge shall be given by honorable Vice chancellor of HNG university.
- 4. She/He shall be awarded the Gender Champion Trophy.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF A GENDER CHAMPION

- 1. Provide overall guidance to the peer group in integration/ mainstreaming gender in all activities of the campus in the form of focused group discussions, debates, poster competitions etc.
- 2. Identify gaps in department activities vis-a-vis gender, and make recommendations on how to address these gaps.
- Promote Gender Champion Club in various departments of campus and undertake innovative activities, like creation website or blog on gender equity, untold story of extraordinary boys, girls and transgender who change lives of women, enabling legislations, government schemes or about finding new gender Champion in campus. Analyzing greeting cards from gender perspective, organize film fest on gender equity etc.
- 4. Organize awareness programs on various gender issues including legislation to influence behavior change. This could be facilitated through workshop, theme based plays, films, painting competition, etc.
- 5. Encourage students to sign up and express their support for gender justice and equality in attractively designed Gender Champion Booths
- 6. Popularize phone numbers of such services as police helpline, women helpline and hospital among students.
